M. DiSanti's comments for 10 July 2015 review of the CARA (Collection of Cometary AfRho values) dataset, for PDS/SBN

collection_description.dat:

(1) Had trouble finding this file => Move from "Notes" area into the main bundle of the dataset (planned).

(2) A few typos are noted.

(3) Second paragraph: "Comets are a typical targets ..." Should this be "Comets are typical targets" or "Comets are atypical targets"? (I suspect it's the first one.)

In "cara_description.txt" column 7 is listed as "Measured Magnitude" but this is described as "brightness" in the .xml files. This can be easily understood to mean magnitude (presumably in the specified filter), which can be tied to physical units through measurement of a reference star and zero-point mag. But would a description simply as "magnitude" be better?
